## Myth

PFAS\* in Synagro's Granulite® fertilizer caused animal deaths in Johnson County, Texas.

PFAS in the Granulite impacted land in Johnson County.

PFAS from Granulite applied to a property in Grandview, Johnson County, leached onto neighboring land.

Testing done by Public Employees for Environmental Responsibility (PEER) on neighboring properties followed scientific standards.

Extremely high PFAS levels were found on the neighboring properties.

The City of Fort Worth ended its contract with Synagro over PFAS concerns.

## Fact

Autopsies performed by Texas A&M University did not cite PFAS as the cause of death of any animals tested.

Independent, third-party testing by Parsons Corporation in collaboration with Dr. Linda Lee, a PFAS expert with Purdue University, found no link between the Granulite and alleged elevated PFAS levels.

The third-party study shows PFAS on the neighboring land did not come from the Granulite.

Unlike the third-party testing, PEER's testing did not follow EPA-endorsed testing methods.

PFAS levels on the Grandview site and neighboring properties are below Texas Protective Concentration Levels and consistent with normal background levels across the nation.

The contract termination was a mutual decision following contract disagreements and unrelated to PFAS in any way.
